TOURNAMENT RULES

Competition will include team or individual entries. There will be a team champion and an individual champion with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place awards for both tournaments. Any conventional fly pattern of any dry, wet, nymph, streamer, and terrestrial may be used. Contestants may choose their fly pattern after they examine their first beat. The fly chosen shall be the same fly used for the day. No strike indicators. The flies will be registered by the controller prior to the start of the competition. Repair of flies may only be done with the use of glue or any adhesive. Any re-tying of the fly with thread or fly tying material will be prohibited. However, broken hooks may be honed back to usable sharpness with any sharpening tool. No lead-headed jigs or modified spinning lure type flies will be approved. Catch and Release only. Stream Guides will measure length of your catch for points to be applied individually or to a team total. If a fly is lost on a beat, the contestant may continue fishing through that session but points will not accumulate for fish. Contestant may use another similar fly on the next beat and re-enter the point competition.
